- Work with the Livestock Agent and Area Grains Agent with test plots, collecting and recording data as well as assisting with preparation for field days, assisting with yield measurements, scouting for disease and insect damage and weeds in field and forage crops as well as assessment of problems
- Work with the Horticulture Agent and assist with homeowner and commercial calls as well as work with small farms program.
- Opportunity to work with the 4-H and Youth summer program, poultry judging, livestock and dairy judging assisting with training teams for competition.
- Opportunities to work with Family and Consumer Sciences Agent with Health and Wellness and Food Safety Initiative.

- Experience in the areas of livestock and field crops would be beneficial (Animal Science, Crop and Soil Science classes)
